Actual realisation policy for the coming 4 years

We will focus on the Exchange of Knowledge between institutes for Skill Development (MBO and HBO) from The Netherlands to India mainly through internship program in cooperation with Mineral Foundation of Goa and RCPR Agrischool in Goa.

Internships in the Care sector are organised for students from Koning Willem 1 College and institutes in Goa with help of the Mineral Foundation of Goa.

Internships and Research programs in Food Technology for students from HAS University of Applied Sciences are organized with help of RCPR Agrischool and the Farmer's Group at the Chamber of Commerce & Industries in Goa

After a good Pilot program in 2018 in Goa with students from Koning Willem 1 College in 's-Hertogenbosch and a very good program in 2019, Koning Willem 1 College has expressed that they want to continue the cooperation for the program in Goa, although the Covid Pandemic is blocking developments for 2020 and 2021. Communication about future plans with MFG are still continuing for a new program in 2022.

We also have a very good Research program for students from HAS University of Applied Sciences from the sector of Food Technology and also HAS would like to continue the cooperation for their students as soon as possible.

The Academic year in India always finishes at the end of April and starts the first of July. If you have to cooperate with the Education sector in India from Dutch Education institutes there is a loss of 4 months that you are not able to communicate.

Rewarding of activities

The members of the board receive no remuneration for their activities.

They are, however, entitled to the reimbursement of the expenses made by them in the exercise of their function during their programs in India, at the Education Institutes Koning Willem 1 College and Has University of Applied Sciences.
